It would have felt a lot less frustrating had there been a guide to what the solution should be, as sometimes there was no indication of how close I was to a solution.
	(ISYE 4134) I would strongly recommend making this course synchronous, so students know to have the interactive sessions in their calendar upon registering. I do not think this would cause conflicts with many other courses and would help students in planning.
