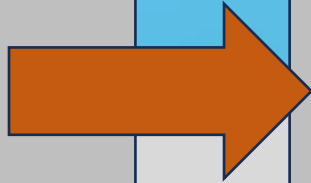
# Events Coordinator – Ethan Wheelock

Residents and RAs submit bills for events and initiatives by submitting a bill online before Community Council meeting

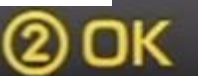
Community Council attendees from Nelson-Shell hear the bill, question the author, discuss and vote pass, fail, or abstain.


